8. Meeting Adjournment – Meeting adjourned at 11:22 AM.

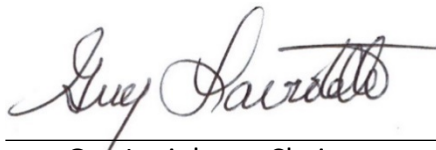
